The zine compiles student art, photography, and writings from Barnard College and Columbia University students, generally focusing on music and WBAR history. The zine has had different titles over the years, including *Static*, *radiation\**, *xXWBARXx*, and simply the WBAR zine.

This compilation zine is made by students associated with WBAR, Barnard College's student radio station, and includes black-and-white photocollages, illustrations, and text.
