This collection is comprised of materials that document and promote the Department of Theatre's productions and events from the 1920s to 2014.

Materials include flyers, posters, programs, new clippings, press releases, analog and born digital photographs, slides, negatives, contact sheets, digital media, and one artifact, a dreidel.

Also included in this collection is "The First Steps in Speaking Verse," an undated script by Maude Adams which includes an anthology of poems.

From 1978-1992, the Department of Theatre kept programs, flyers, and other performance ephemera in scrapbooks, which comprise series 2 of this collection.
