Lester Bernstein was a former editor of Newsweek magazine who also wrote for The New York Times, was a foreign correspondent for Time magazine and, as a vice president of NBC in 1960, helped arrange America's first televised presidential debates. In a career spanning a half-century, Mr. Bernstein was a theater columnist for The Times; a Rome and London correspondent for Time; a senior Newsweek editor in the 1960s and '70s; and the magazine's chief editor from 1979 to 1982, when it won national awards for general excellence and indepth reporting.
