Biographical sketch

Bashmakov was an ethnographer in Russia and, after the Civil War, in France. His major works include "La synthèse des périples pontiques" and "Cinquante siècles d'évolution ethnique autour de la mer noire." He was also associated with the emigre monarchists in France, and was a member of Grand Duke Kirill's "state council" (gosudarevo soveshchanie). Mariia Bashmakova was the author of a volume of memoirs, *Mémoires* (as Marie de Bashmakoff).

Scope and Content

These papers consist of correspondence, manuscripts, documents, subject files, photographs, and printed materials. Most of the collection concerns Bashmakov's ethnographical work in France in the 1920s and 1930s, including correspondence, many manuscripts, lectures, notes, and copies of his publications. Subject files concern emigre monarchism in France, and the death of Father Georgii Spasskii. There are copies of the Russian version of Bashmakova's memoirs, "Perezhitoe." Cataloged correspondence in the collection consists of letters from Petr Krasnov and one or two items each from Henry Field, Evgenii Miller, Petr Wrangel, and Boris Zaitsev. There are also photographic slides representing ethnographical types from the Caucasus.
