Biographical sketch

Konstantin Vasil'evich Ialyshev (1881 - 1971), officer in the Imperial and White armies, colonel. Joined the army after graduating from the Law School of Kyiv University, participated in the second half of the Russo-Japanese War. In 1918 - in the Hetman Army, from November 20, 1918 assistant chief of court under the General Staff. Joined the Armed Forces of Southern Russia. Emigrated to Constantinople, then Yugoslavia and then France.

Scope and Content

The papers consist of manuscripts, subject files and printed materials. Manuscripts include K. V. Ialyshev's memoirs, which deal with his student days in Kyiv at the turn of the century, including unrest in 1900, and with the Russo-Japanese war. There are also a manuscript by A. A. Vishnevskii on the "Ukrainian question" and manuscript of unidentified author on R.O.S. Subject files include records of various emigre organizations, including Bratstvo Sv. Nikolaia in Constantinople, of which Ialyshev was the president; Ob"edinenie intellektual'nykh russkikh truzhennikov vo Frantsii; Ob"edinenie XVIII-go Armeiskago Korpusa, Rossiiskii zarubezhnyi s"ezd; "Victor Hugo" refugee camp near Marseilles; Union des Anciens Combattants Russes and Union Patriotique des Exiles Politiques Russes oi Marseille. Printed material include brochure and periodicals.
