Scope and Content

The papers consist of correspondence, manuscripts, documents, and printed materials. Correspondence includes 3 letters from Mikhaïl Karpovich, and letters from Khmel'niĭskaia's son Sergeï, a writer in the Soviet Union. Among the manuscripts is Khmel'niĭskaia's autobiography, which discusses her childhood in Odessa and her education; and her translation of the letters of William Frey, a Russian immigrant in Kansas in the 1870s.
