Served in the Imperial Ministries of Justice and Internal Affairs in 1896-1907, then became a senator, and in 1916-17 was the last State Secretary of the Empire.

Scope and Content

The papers consist of correspondence, manuscripts, subject files, and printed materials. Correspondence includes letters by Vladimir Kokovtsov, and letters concerning the posthumous publication of Kryzhanovskii's memoirs. Manuscripts include drafts of these memoirs and other items by Kryzhanovskii. There are also manuscripts, chiefly memoirs, by other persons; most were evidently sent to Kryzhanovskii as editor of the emigre journal "Russkaiâ Letopis" in the 1920s, but were never published. They deal with such topics as the Imperial police and government and the 1917 Revolution and the Civil War. There is a large group of manuscripts and related printed items, evidently prepared by Kryzhanovskii, on the projected governmental

system of a post-Bolshevik Russia. Subject files deal with the 1917 Revolution, emigre monarchism, and other topics.
