Mitrofanova's manuscripts consist of four bound typescripts: memoirs about her son, Oleg P. Mitrofanov, and the Preobrazhenskii Regiment in World War I; and two essays on the White Cross, entitled "Beloe dvizhenie i Belyi Krest" and "Belyi Krest' v izgnanii." Also included is Oleg Mitrofanov's diary, which covers his service in the Preobrazhenskii guard in January-July 1917.
