Acted as legal consultant for the Russian Orthodox Church in Poland until 1933. Later in the United States he became president of the Ob"edinenie Russkikh IURistov Byvshikh D.P. v Amerike (Union of Russian Jurists (Former Displaced Persons) in America).

---

Papers include correspondence, manuscripts, and printed materials. Correspondence mostly concerns the Ob"edinenie in the 1950s. One of the manuscripts by Nikolaev is entitled "Ukrainsko-pol'skie otnosheniã vo vremã sovetsko-pol'skoï voïny 1920-1921 gg." Nikolaev's memoirs largely concern his activities as legal consultant to the Orthodox Church in Poland. Printed materials deal mostly with the Ob"edinenie.
