Summary

The papers consist of correspondence, manuscripts, documents, photographs, and printed materials, chiefly concerning 1907-1917. They are particularly useful for the study of the second Russian State Duma (1907), the Russian Social Democratic School on Capri, the "Vpered" group of Social Democrats, the relationship between Maksim Gorkii and Leonid Andreev, and World War I. Russian Social Democratic correspondents include Aleksandr Bogdanov, Vladimir Lenin, Anatolii Lunacharskii, TUlii Martov, Georgii Plekhanov, Mikhail Pokrovskii, and Lev Trotīskii. There are letters by such European socialists as Pablo Iglesias Posse, Karl Kautsky, Rosa Luxemburg, and Benito Mussolini, and a series of letters from Gorkii to Andreev (1899-1915). There is a large number of petitions ("nakazy" "prosheniiā" etc.) sent by people to Aleksinskii when he was a Duma delegate. Authors of manuscripts in the collection include Vicente Blasco Ibáñez, Gorkii, Lenin, and Lunacharskii. Printed materials consist of Aleksinskii's writings, issues of chiefly Russian emigre periodicals from 1908 to the 1960s, books by various persons, and ephemera.
