Biographical sketch

Nikolai Nikolaevich Chebyshev (1865-1937), procurator, first in Kiev, then in Moscow, and Senator under the Provisional Government, journalist. After emigrating to France, Chebyshev wrote for the Parisian Russian language periodical "Vozrozhdenie" where he was a member of the staff.

Summary

The collection contains correspondence from N. N. Evreinov, V. A. Maklakov, P. N. Shatilov, Petr Struve, and P. N. Vrangeli; manuscripts, primarily notes and drafts of articles; and photographs. Most of the collection consists of Chebyshev's articles from the period 1921-1936. These articles are on political, cultural, and human interest subjects. There are also books, booklets, and a scrapbook.
