## **Biographical / Historical**

Sophie Kerr (1880-1965) was a novelist and short story writer. Ms. Kerr was one of the most successful and prolific authors in the age of entertainment writing that preceded the television era. During a career that spanned six decades, she published 23 volumes and several hundred short stories along with essays, and plays.

## Summary

The papers contain 273 drafts, manuscripts, and typescripts representing every genre in which Ms. Sophie Kerr worked along with correspondence, book artwork, and photographs.

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In addition, it includes 12 book-length manuscripts, the earliest being *Love at Large*, a novel published in 1916. The collection also holds books written by Sophie Kerr and volumes inscribed to her from her personal library.
