Originally the plan was for a 2 volume work, but this was later changed to 1 volume. All of the Jan Hus material was withdrawn, the largest portion of material in this collection. Material about others includes Cardinal Peter D'Ailly of Cambrai, John Petit, Pope Martin V, and Bishop-elect William of Strasburh, and annates on the tax problem. John H. Mundy, professor of history, Columbia University, and Kennerly M. Woody completed the editing of this book after Loomis' death.
