Wilson was born in Waco, Texas on 4 October 1941. He attended the University of Texas Austin, 1959-1962 and the Pratt Institute, 1962-1965 where he earned a BFA in architecture. In 1969 he was appointed artistic director of the Byrd Hoffmann Foundation, New York from where he has produced most of his works. Wilson is known for his performance art. He has taught and lectured in the United States and Europe and exhibited as a sculptor and artist worldwide.

Series II contains press materials for 1988 and research materials for *King Lear*, *The Forest*, and *Parsifal*, as well as miscellaneous research files for 1987. In addition, one can find various documents (letters, contracts, etc.) relating to the following productions: *The Forest*, *Alcestis*; *The Golden Windows*; *Patio*; *Edison*; *Black Rider*; *Murder (Deafman Glance)*; *CIVIL warS*; and *Knee Plays*. A group of miscellaneous files follows, containing such items as scores, research materials, and budget documentation. In the oversize folders of the series are scores for *The Golden Windows* and *De Materie*, research for *Black Rider*, a press kit for *Knee Plays*, and various *King Lear* documents.
