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### **Biographical Note**

Warrent Fredetick Goodell first came to Columbia in 1946 as a graduate student in Physics. After receiving his doctorate in 1951, he assumed his first administrative post as Associate Director of the Nevis Cyclotron Laboratories. He became Assistant to the Vice President for Administration when the post was created in 1967. In this position, Goodell served as assistant to the President and to Vice President for Administration Paul Carter. He was involved with the University's day-to-day operations. After he left Columbia in 1972, his position was eliminated.

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#### Summary

This collections contains the records of Warren F. Goodell as Associate Director of the Office of Projects and Grants and later as Assistant to the Vice President for Administration. The records relate to fundraising campaigns, major gifts and University planning, including materials Goodell inherited from Stanley Salmen, Coordinator of University Planning. Goodell's administrative roles also facilities, real estate, campus expansion and the Computer Center. There are also materials (flyers, newspaper clipplings, radio and television coverage transcripts, etc.) related the student strike in 1968.
