From the mid-1960s through the beginning of the 20th century, Davidson collected Englishlanguage materials on Japanese haiku and books and periodicals of haiku in English. From 1968 to 1988 she maintained extensive correspondence with many poets of the haiku movement in North America. Materials include books and papers.
