Born in Brooklyn, New York. A.B., Vassar College, 1937; M.A., Middlebury College, 1949; M.S., Columbia University, 1954. She was research secretary and later research assistant in Russian studies at the Russian Institute of Columbia University from 1946 to 1954; and in the fall of 1961 she served as a senior fellow of the Institute for a period of research including travel in the Soviet Union. Contributed to a number of professional publications, including "The Library Quarterly," Constance Winchell's "Selected Reference Books" series in College and Research Libraries, Guide to Reference Books, American Documentation. Her review articles
