## Biographical / Historical

Eleanor Buist, Slavic bibliographer, senior reference librarian of Columbia University Libraries, executive secretary of the Coordinating Committee for Slavic and East European Library Resources of the Joint Committee on Slavic Studies and the Association of Research Libraries. Born in Brooklyn, New York. A.B., Vassar College, 1937; M.A., Middlebury College, 1949; M.S., Columbia University, 1954. She was research secretary and later research assistant in Russian studies at the Russian Institute of Columbia University from 1946 to 1954; and in the fall of 1961 she served as a senior fellow of the Institute for a period of research including travel in the Soviet Union. Contributed to a number of professional publications, including "The Library Quarterly," Constance Winchell's "Selected Reference Books" series in College and Research Libraries, Guide to Reference Books, American Documentation. Her review articles

include "Soviet Publishing," and a translation, "Training the Soviet Student in Bibliography and Information Techniques."
