He has received grants and fellowships from the American Philosophical Society, the National Endowment of the Humanities, the Rockefeller Foundation, the American Council of Learned Societies, and the Louisville Institute. Dickerson taught at Williams College from 1976 to 1999, as well as at Rhodes College, Yale Divinity School, and the Payne Theological Seminary.
